

Saving an Audacity file (.aup), Export the file as an MP3, and Locating the lame_enc.dll File

To continue you need to record an audio file first, if you have do already done so.

Open Audacity (there is an icon on your desktop).

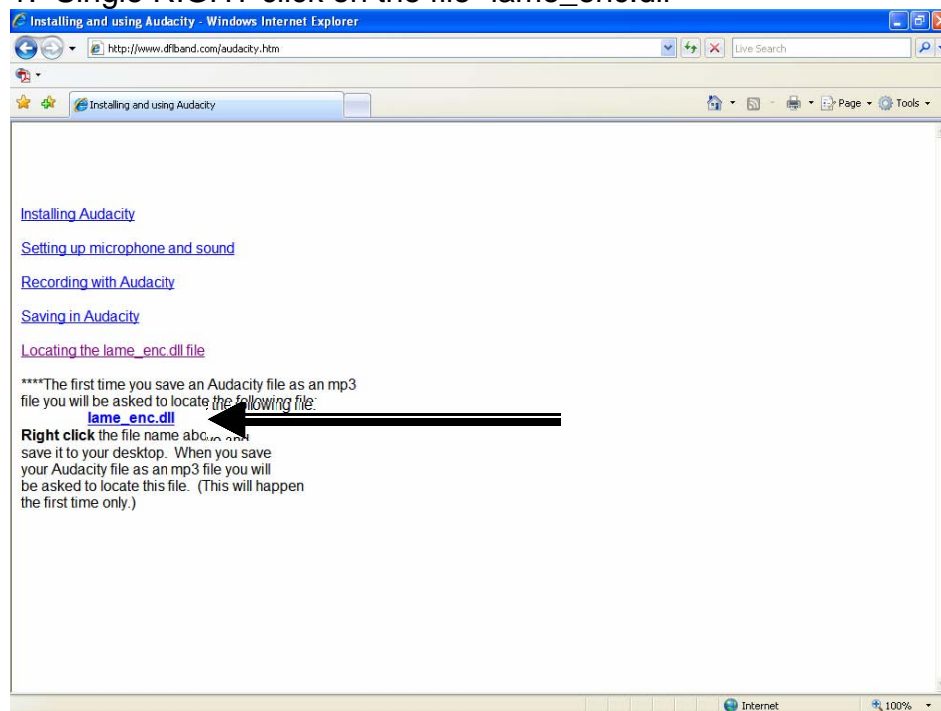
Make a recording.

Once you have finished recording, go to menu bar and click "File", then select "Save Project". Give the file a name (for example, "Bbscale.aup"). Click save. This will save your file as an Audacity project. You can later edit the sound file.

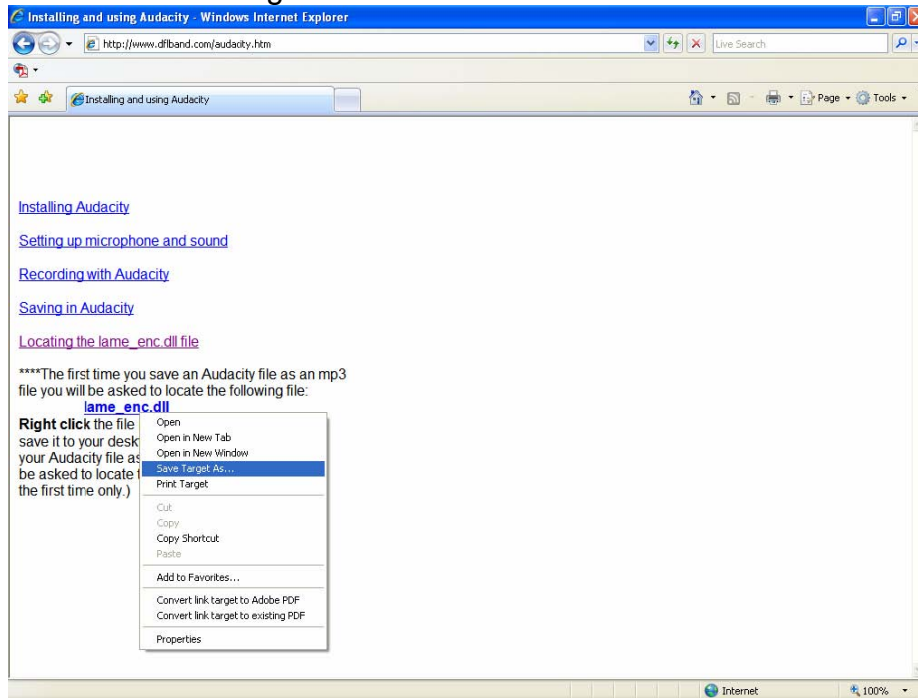
The following process needs to be done one time only.

Open your browser and go to: www.DFLBAND.com/audacity.htm .

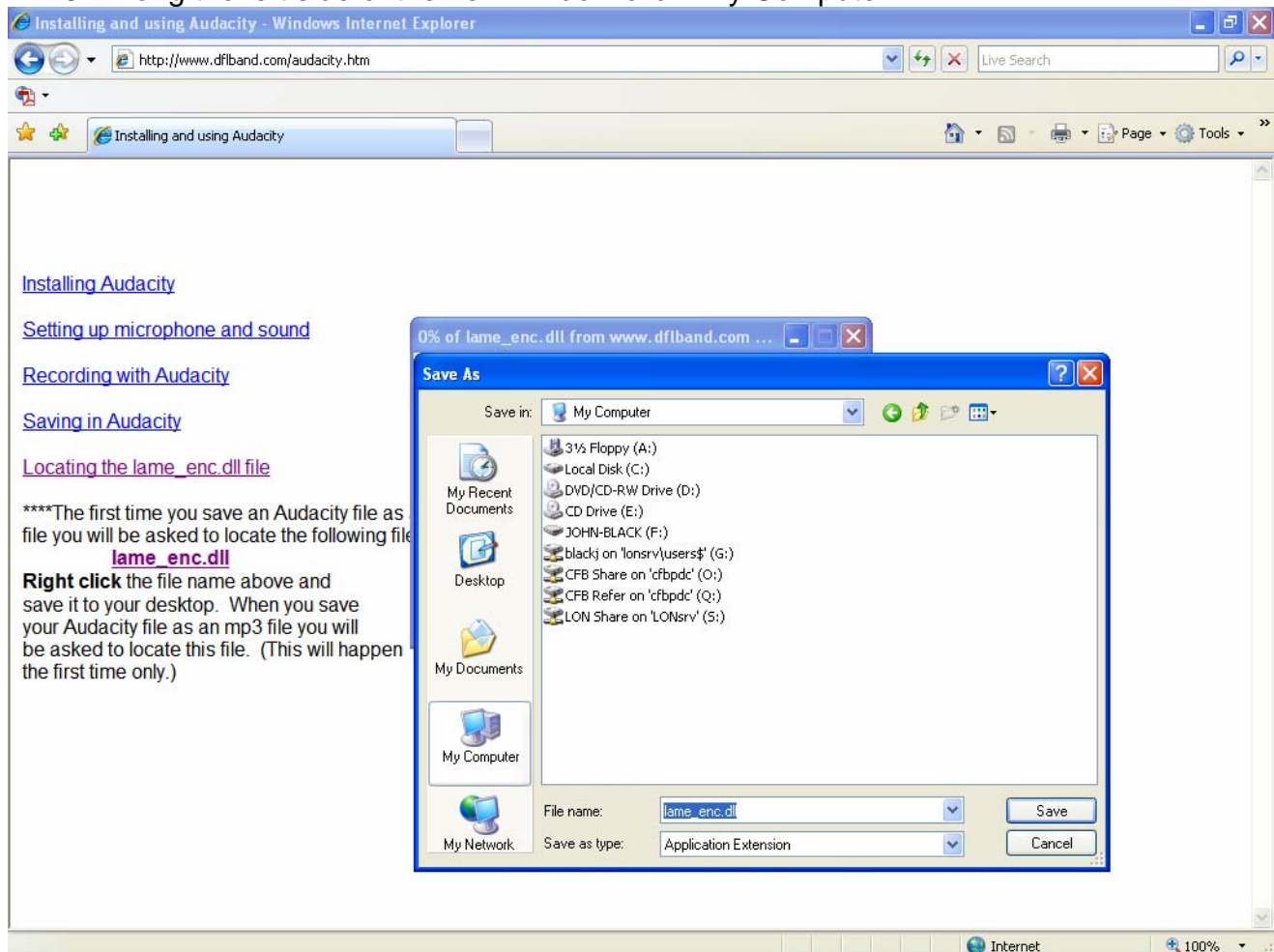
1. Single RIGHT click on the file "lame_enc.dll"



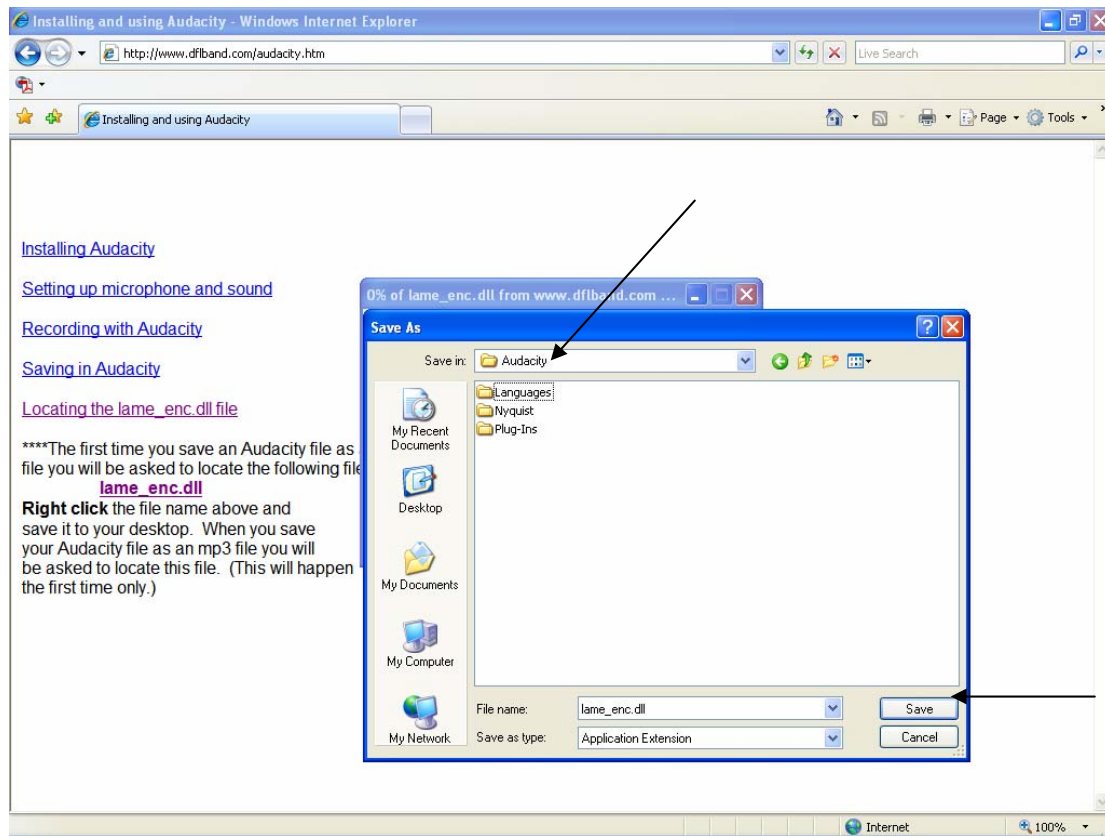
2. Select "save target as".



3. Along the left side of the new window click "My Computer".



4. Click on the C:\ drive
5. Open the "Program Files" folder
6. Open the "Audacity" folder
7. Click "save".

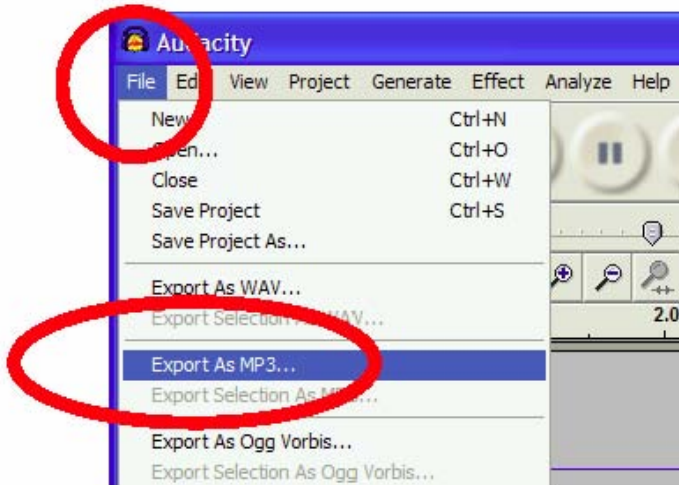


Next you will need to export your file as an MP3 file.

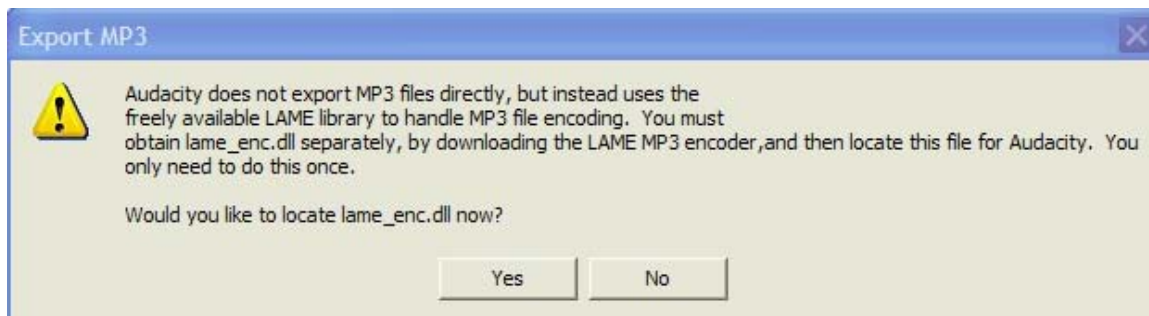
From the menu bar in Audacity, click “File”, select “Export as MP3 file”.

The next window is the “Save MP3 File As:” window, you have to decide where you are going to save your file. The best place is the C:\ drive to a folder. Give your file a filename then click Save.

You will get a “Warning” message that asks if you really want to save the file as an MP3, click “Yes”.



The following message will appear:

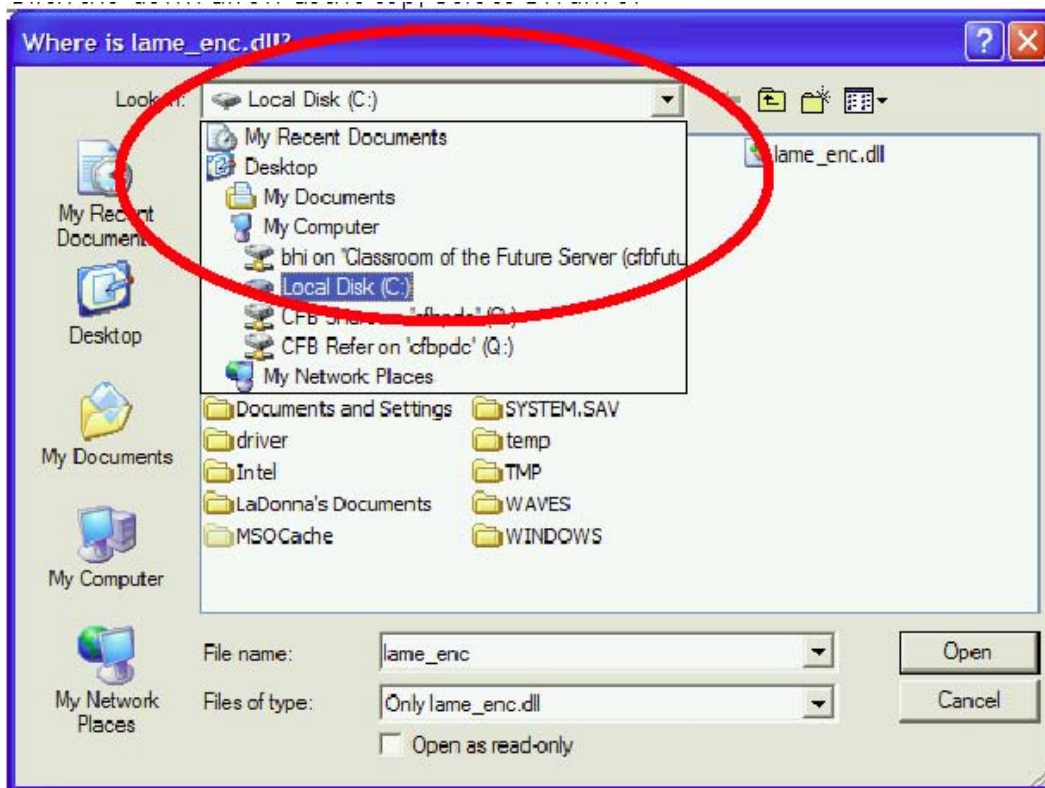


When you export as an MP3 file, Audacity will ask you to locate the “lame_enc.dll” file.

Click “yes”.

The next window allows you to go find the “lame_enc.dll” file. Previously in the directions you copied this file to the Audacity folder.

Click the down arrow at the top, select C:\ drive:



Double click the “Program Files” Folder.

Double click the “Audacity” Folder.

Inside the Audacity folder, you will see the “lame_enc.dll” file.
Single click the “lame_enc.dll” file, then click Open. (You really do have to do this only the first time.)
