REMINDERS

1. **Bring money for lunch, snacks, and drinks.** (Small cups of water are free at concessions when you ask for it. There are water fountains in the park.) No outside food or drink is allowed except for medical reasons. The lines at the concession stands are shorter when you eat meals earlier or later than normal. Meals tend to be rather large and can be shared if you do not eat a “big” lunch.
2. **Sunscreen.** (The directors will carry extra sunscreen.)
3. Towel. (It is not necessary but you may want one.)
4. You may come to school in your swim suit. (No ID’s.) **Flip flops**, swim shoes, or tennis shoes are ok. (There is a changing area at the park.)
5. Drink plenty of water through-out the day! Be sure to eat.
6. If you forget something, tell Mr. Black or Mrs. Parks.
7. Lockers are available to store valuables. Last year’s price \$12-medium, \$14-large, \$16-extralarge. You may want to share a locker. Do not leave valuables or money unattended. Locker rental includes unlimited access during the day.
8. Only a few parts of the pools/rides are in deep water. If you want to wear a life preserver they are usually located around the Surf Lagoon in the center of the park. There is no cost.
9. We will meet around the locker area at 6:00 before going to the bus.
10. If you need help during the day ask any park worker and they will be able to take care of you or they will help locate the directors.
11. It’s going to be HOT. The water will feel great. Have fun and try lots of different rides.
12. A school bus will take you to and from Hurricane Harbor. If you are planning on leaving early with a parent, written notice must be given to the directors in advance.
