Fine Arts Enrichment programs are vital to the success of the student and the performing groups. In order for Dan F. Long and each student to be on the same level as other schools in this region, students need to participate in some form of private lessons. A major emphasis will be placed on the quality of the lesson program this year and we hope to have as many students involved as possible.

A typical lesson is 30 minutes long and held once a week. Each lesson costs \$15. Group lessons may be available with each student paying \$10 per lesson. (A group lesson will include two or three students.) Parents pay for lessons a month at a time at the start of the month. Many private lesson instructors are able to teach lessons during band class while some need to schedule before-school or after-school times.

Lesson teachers are hired by the band directors according to CFBISD policy after going through interviews and background checks. The band directors monitor lessons.
